

Application to provide Get There DRT Transportation Services

Only a registered Australian company can apply to provide GT DRT transportation services.

Note: *“Transportation Services”* means the provision of passenger transportation services to Users and User Passengers via the GT Services in the Territory by the Transport Provider and its Drivers using the Vehicles.

As the applicant to provide GT DRT transportation services, you acknowledge and agree that GT is a technology services provider that does not itself provide transportation services, function as a transportation carrier, nor operate as an agent for the transportation of passengers.

Comply with DRT Transport Provider Terms and Conditions

The Transport Provider must continue to fully comply with the GT DRT Transport Provider Terms and Conditions.

Documentation required to be provided with this application:

If the applicant is an accredited bus operator, a copy of the current Certificate of Accreditation.

Vehicle documents

For each vehicle the contractor proposes to use to provide transportation services, including ‘relief’ vehicles, true and correct copies of:

- Current certificate of registration for each vehicle; and
- A vehicle inspection certificate for each vehicle

Insurance documents

Copies of certificates of currency for:

- public liability insurance for at least \$20 million per occurrence;
- workers compensation insurance as required by law;
- third party property damage insurance for at least \$20 million per occurrence in respect of the Vehicles; and
- compulsory third party motor vehicle insurance in respect of the Vehicle used to provide the Transportation Services;

Note: All insurances which the TP effects in compliance with this Agreement will be effected with insurers having a minimum Rating of at least A- (Standard & Poor's Australia) or an equivalent Rating.

Documents relating to employee drivers will need to be provided after the applicant becomes a GT approved Transport Provider.

Application Process

Your application will be assessed when all the required documentation has been provided. If any documentation is missing, you will be notified as to what further documentation needs to be provided before your application can be assessed.

Approval notification or rejection

If your application is approved, you will receive a copy of a signed agreement between you and GT.

The 'Commencement Date' for the Agreement is that date that written approval (if at all) is provided by GT for the applicant to provide transportation services.

Important Notice

Submission of this application is not an authority for the applicant to perform any work/services. The applicant must not perform any services for GT until, and only if, approved by GT in writing to provide such services.
